Risk Assessment, Support, and Supervision :

This volunteer position is medium risk. Volunteers at this position will require supervision at regular intervals. Support is always available whenever necessary.

Orientation :

Volunteers are required to complete the training on: Monday, July 17, 2023; 4:30 to 6:30 PM

Time Frame / Level of Commitment :

- Volunteers for this position must be available on the event day
- Potential volunteers must be available for a minimum of 4 hours
- Period of volunteering short-term (one-off)

Application Process and Screening Measures :

- Attend information session
- Complete Criminal Records Check for those volunteering in Children's and Seniors' Pavilions
- Fill out the online application form
- Attend orientation and training
- Once we have received your information and have reviewed it for appropriate qualifications, we will be in touch with you to inform you of your status. The volunteer screening and training process may take several weeks.
- Volunteer applicants must be eligible to do volunteer work in Canada.

Frequency of the recruitment for the position :

Volunteer positions listed above are one-day positions and will be open until filled.
