N3xUs Program

Program Description	The N3xUs program allows youth to get a jumpstart on their academic career by providing a supportive environment in the transition from High School, often in small, rural or remote communities, to a post-secondary, academic setting. The program focuses on technology, work-life balance, academic skills, and information about supports, financial needs, and other tools.
Certifications	N3xUs Certificate (CVTC), up to three Microsoft certificates.
Learning Objectives	Upon successful completion of the program, students will be able to enjoy more success within post-secondary settings, understanding more about navigating different tools, technology, and academic supports.
Eligibility Criteria	Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person legally entitled to work in Canada*, living in British Columbia, and not a full-time student. Must be between the ages of 17 and 30 and planning to attend post-secondary schooling.
Program Hours	Classes are scheduled for a mandatory six hours per day, four days a week. Class time is scheduled from Tuesday – Friday, 9:00 – 3:30, with additional lab time after class and every Monday.
Supports	Dependent upon need, supports could include living support, re-location assistance, tuition subsidies, travel or other supports needed to complete the program. Students will also receive a laptop preloaded with Microsoft Office 365 and a CVTC backpack.
Evaluation	Students will be evaluated through participation, assignments, and tests. Successful completion of the program hinges on participation in class and completing assigned work.
Scholarship Requirements	N3xUs Post Secondary tuition subsidies are pro-rated based on program attendance. To be eligible for the full \$3000 scholarship, students must have 100% attendance.
